Dear Friends and Colleagues,

So much have happened since the start of 2020. The **coronavirus COVID-19** has affected **213 countries and territories** around the world and 2 international conveyances. To date, more than 16.6 million affected, and 657,500 deaths and our way of living has indeed changed. ABOUT IFSO

The International Federation for the Surgery of Obesity and metabolic disorders (IFSO) is a Federation composed of national associations of bariatric surgeons and Integrated Health professionals. Currently, there are 67 official member societies of IFSO. There are also individual members from countries that thus far have not formed a national association.

IFSO is a scientific organization that brings together surgeons and integrated health professionals, such as nurse, practitioners, dieticians, nutritionists, psychologists, internists and anaesthesiologists, involved in the treatment of morbidly obese patients.

One of IFSO's main goals is to support its members in aspects directly related to their profession. One of IFSO's main activities is the organization of the yearly World Congress, which provides a forum to exchange knowledge on surgical treatment of severely obese patients, to present new techniques, research and concepts, and to meet the experts in the field.

An international obesity surgery meeting was held annually in various countries throughout the world, under the leadership of Nicola Scopinaro. At the Stockholm meeting in 1995, the International Federation for the Surgery of Obesity (IFSO) was formed. The first International Congress of IFSO was held in Prague in 1996, followed by Cancun in 1997, Bruges in 1998, Salzburg in 1999 and Genoa in 2000. The first President was Nicola Scopinaro (Italy), followed by George Cowan (U.S.A) and Emanuel Hell (Austria).

This statement is based on current clinical knowledge, expert opinion, and published peer-reviewed scientific evidence. It will be reviewed regularly in two years, as per IFSO policy.

DR. MUFFAZAL LAKDAWALA AND HIS FIGHT AGAINST COVID-19





From stadium to isolation centre to hospital: A jumbo fight against Covid-19 at Mumbai's NSCI dome.

Once a popular venue for sports and entertainment in the city, the National Sports Club of India's (NSCI) stadium dome in Worli is now a full-fledged hospital for Covid-19. Since April, it has admitted more than 1,500 patients — including cancer patients, pregnant women, patients with comorbidity — and discharged 1,150 people, boasting of a recovery rate of 76%.

"It was not possible to set up ICUs in a stadium. Every time we had a critical patient, we had to move them to a hospital for an ICU bed. That is when we came up with the idea of ICUs in portable containers. We used shipping containers and converted them to ICUs," said Dr Muffazal Lakdawala, Mumbai-based surgeon who conceptualised the facility at NSCI alongside Maharashtra's environment Minister Aaditya Thackeray, who represents the Worli constituency.

Engineers, researchers, and designers had collaborated on the opensource project, which went from concept to reality in just four weeks. Ever since, such 'container ICUs' have emerged as a potential solution to quickly expand hospital capacity and ease pressure on stressed healthcare systems.

Dr Lakdawala said, "These are full-fledged ICUs. Doctors and nurses will be able to monitor patients from outside the containers. We will have ventilators and high-flow masks too. We are trying to make more of these container ICUs, which they can be transported wherever they are needed most." Sharad Ughade, assistant municipal commissioner, G-South ward, said, "We have made these container ICUs so that critical patients can be treated at NSCI itself, where around 500 Covid-19 patients who are asymptomatic or mildly symptomatic are admitted."


