Jacques Himpens





Professor Jacques Himpens is recognized worldwide as a pioneer of MBS and in particular minimally invasive surgery. He had a key role in the evolution of bariatric and metabolic surgery – which eventually resulted in the Presidency of our Federation in 2017-2018.









He performed the world's first robotic surgery in 1997 in Belgium and the first laparoscopic Belgian nephrectomy.








Performing the first robotic human operation with a da Vinci prototype, a robotic cholecystectomy, in 1997



He taught, mentored and trained dozens of fellows from around the world.


He has changed the lives of several generations of new surgeons worldwide and has contributed to the shift from laparoscopy to robotics.





He became Fellow of the American College of Surgeons and received the ASMBS outstanding lifetime achievement award in 2021








...He got his PhD in Maastricht....

.... And then after the sessions he enjoys the company of his colleagues and good friends from all over the world.....


















