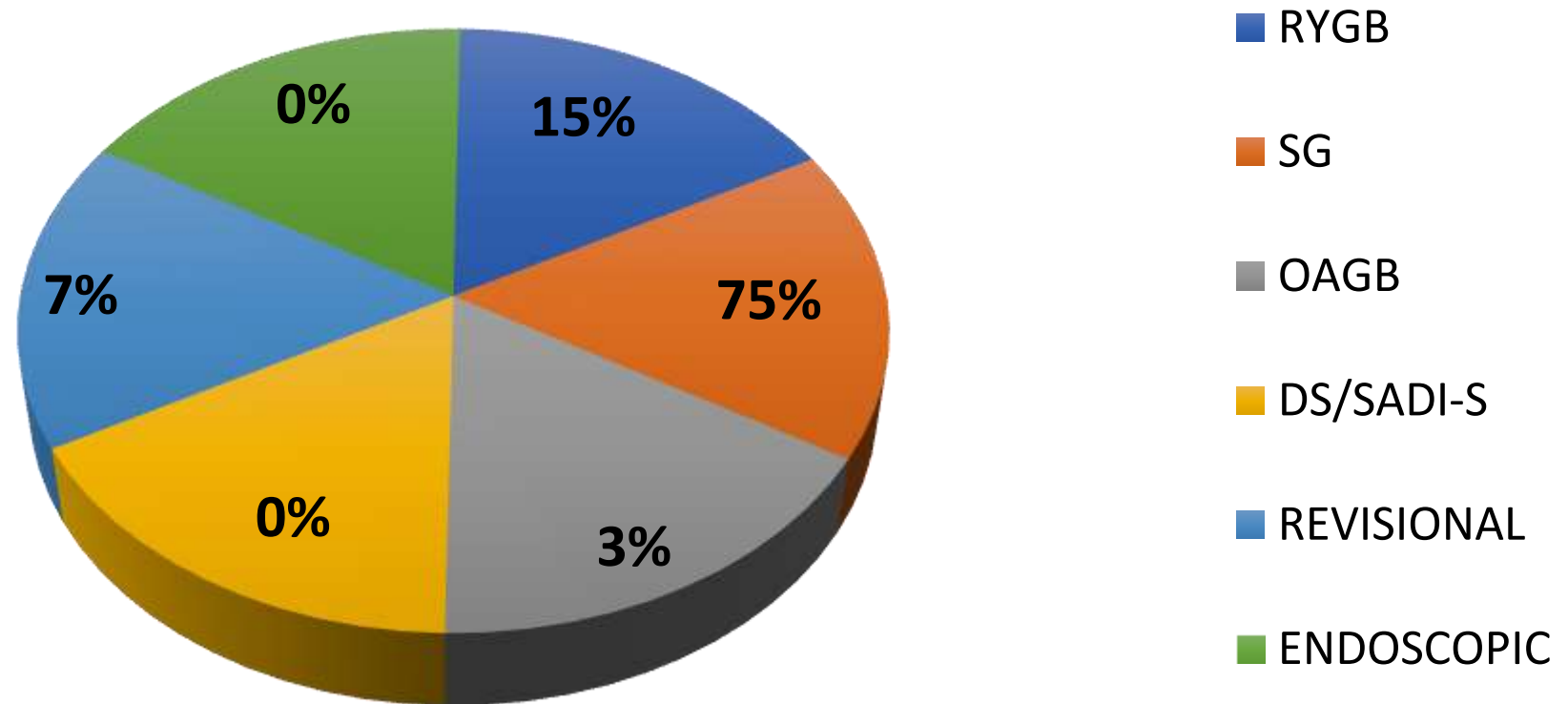

DISCUSSION

- First, Intra-abdominal adhesions might arise as a result of earlier abdominal procedures. In this case, we inserted the initial trochar far from the operation field, released the existing adhesions, and then inserted the other trochars.
- Second, The selection of the right staple for the tissue due to the thickness of the stomach tissue
- The Last, after LSG, the clips that had been placed on the stomach staple line should be removed

Learning Points/Take Home Messages

- Revision procedures are complicated by intra-abdominal adhesions.
- In revision procedures, the thickness of the stomach wall increases, necessitating the use of staples that are compatible with the tissue when forming the stomach pouch.
