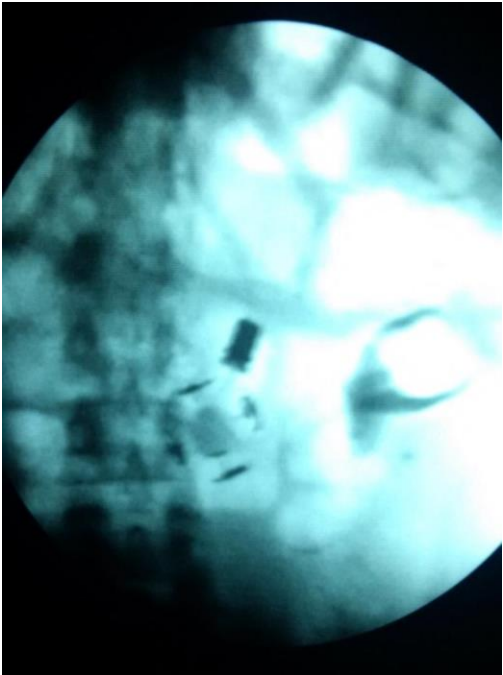

Gastric Band

Minor		
Port leak	< 1%	Port replacement
Port displacement	2.5%–6%	Fluoroscopy fill/readjustment
Minor port infection	< 1.8%	Antibiotics/temporary removal
Pouch enlargement	12%	Deflation, re-education
Major		
Band slip	< 5%	Surgical
Band erosion	< 1%	Removal ←
Late port or band infection	< 1%	Possible erosion
Intra-abdominal abscess	0.1%	Possible erosion

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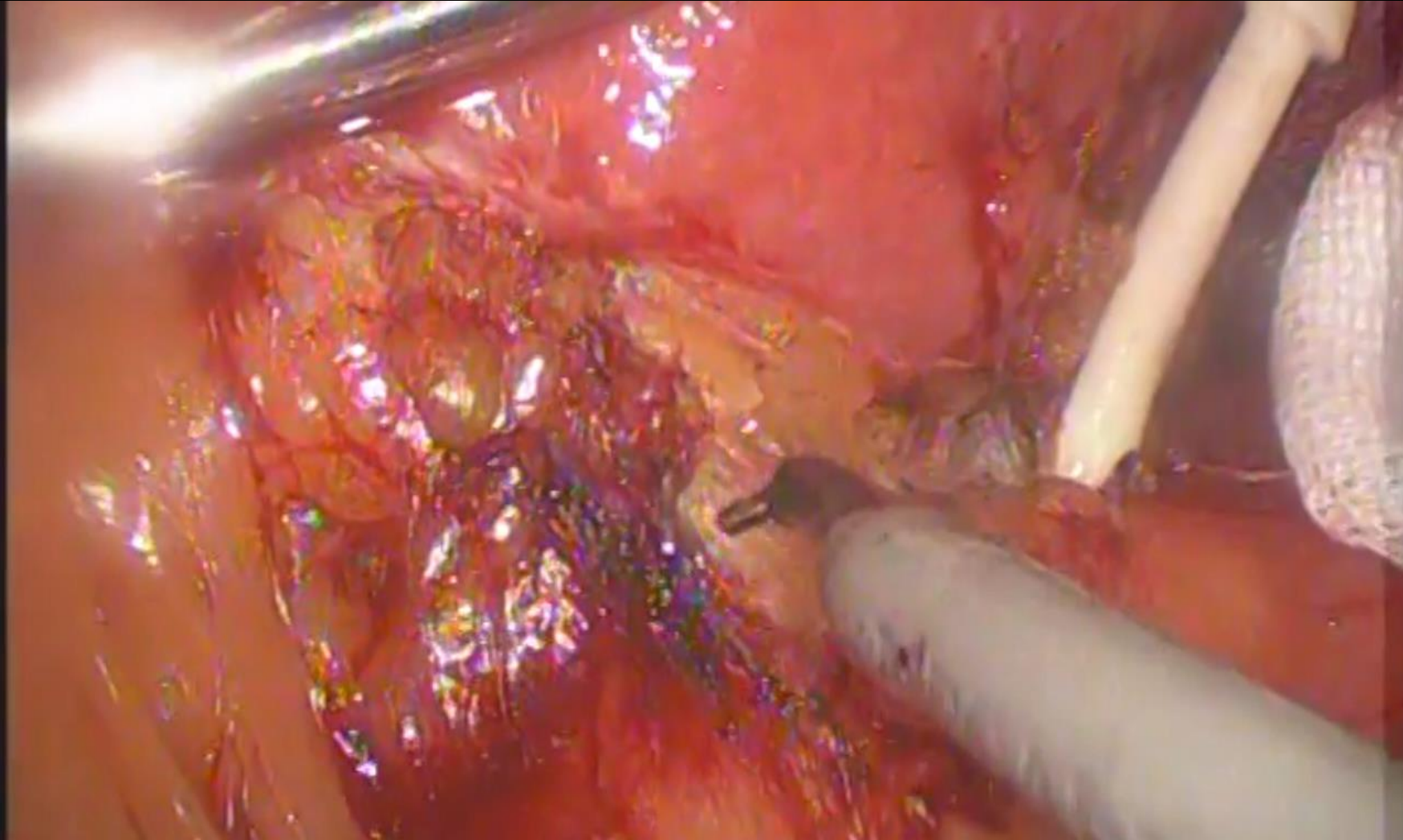

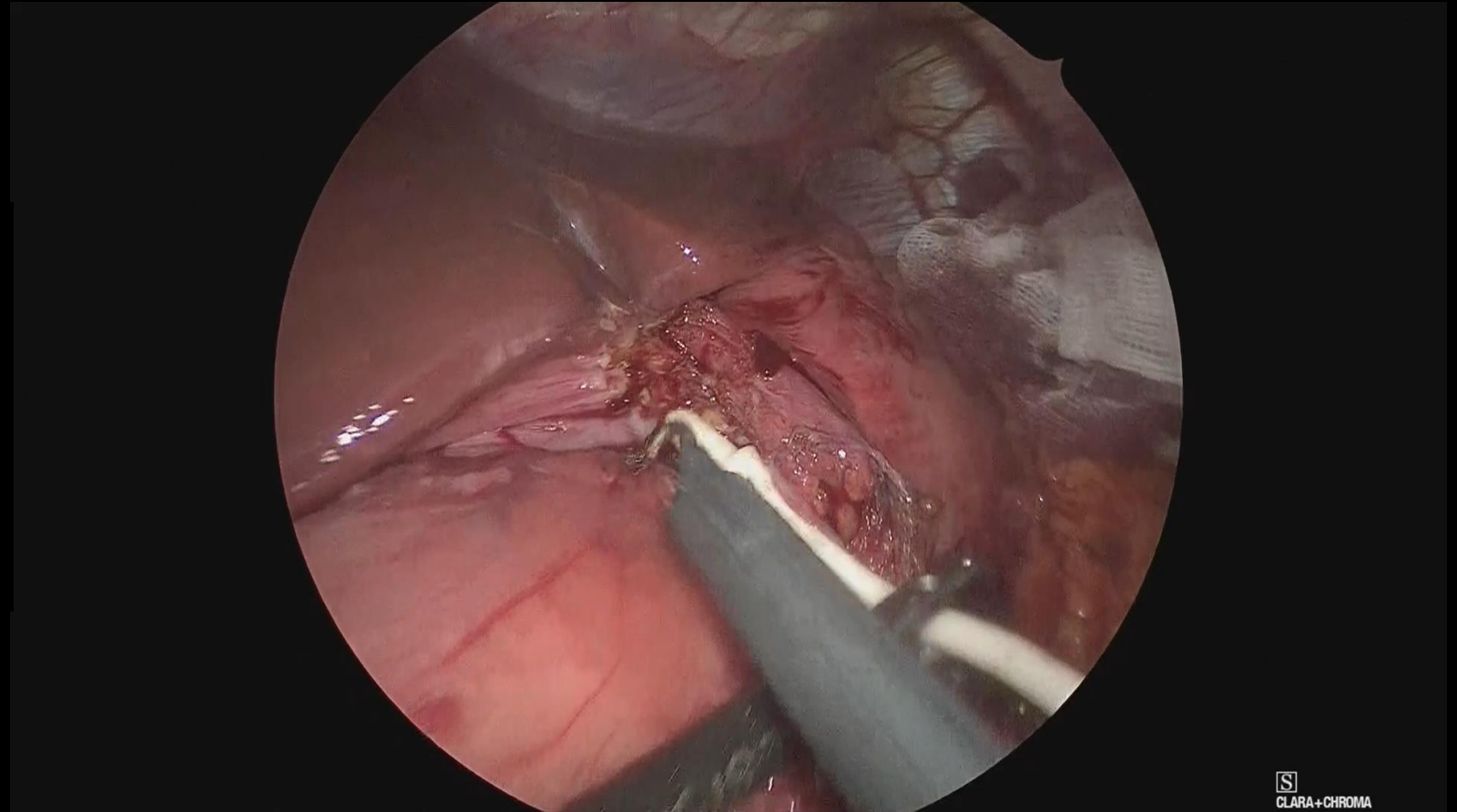

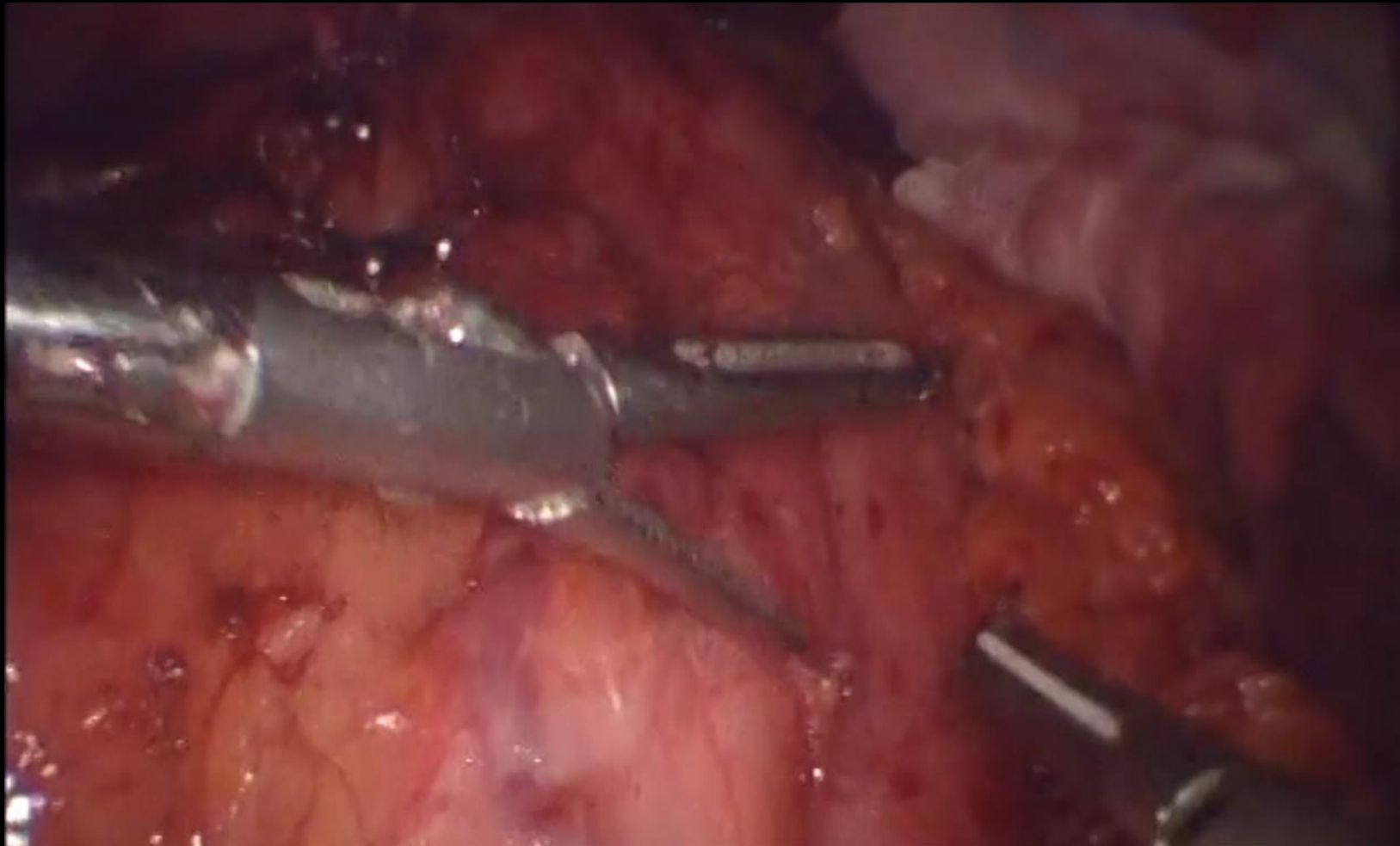

Non adjustable gastric band

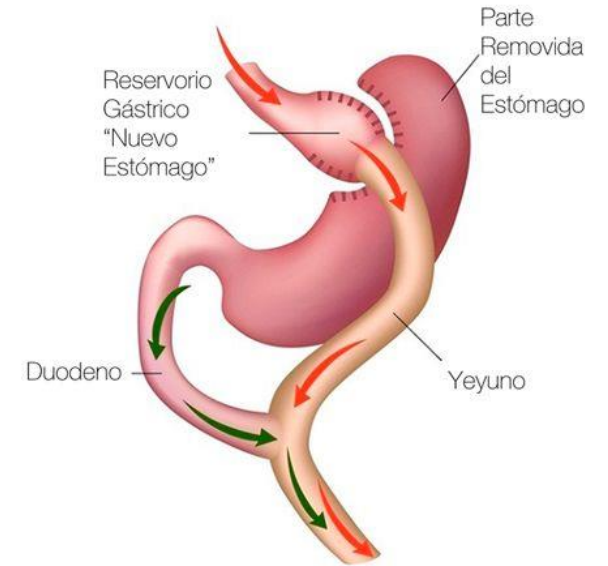


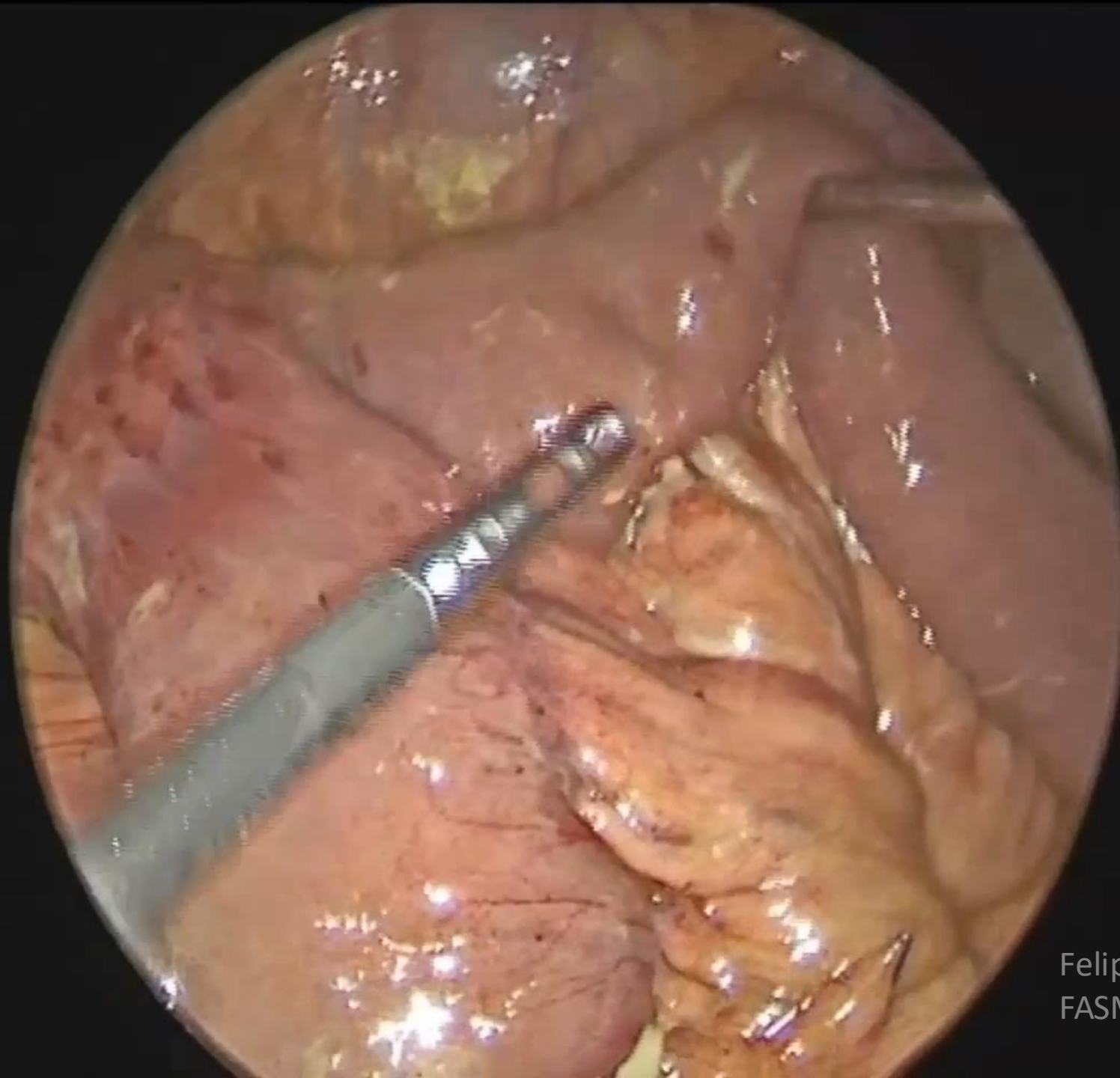
Case 5

- 42 y/o male
- 6 mo. PSHx OAGB
- Initial BMI 40
- Current BMI 28
- HPI: Fever, abdominal pain, SOB, tachycardia, WBC 20.7 K/ul.
- CT: Pneumoperitoneum and free fluid peritoneal cavity.

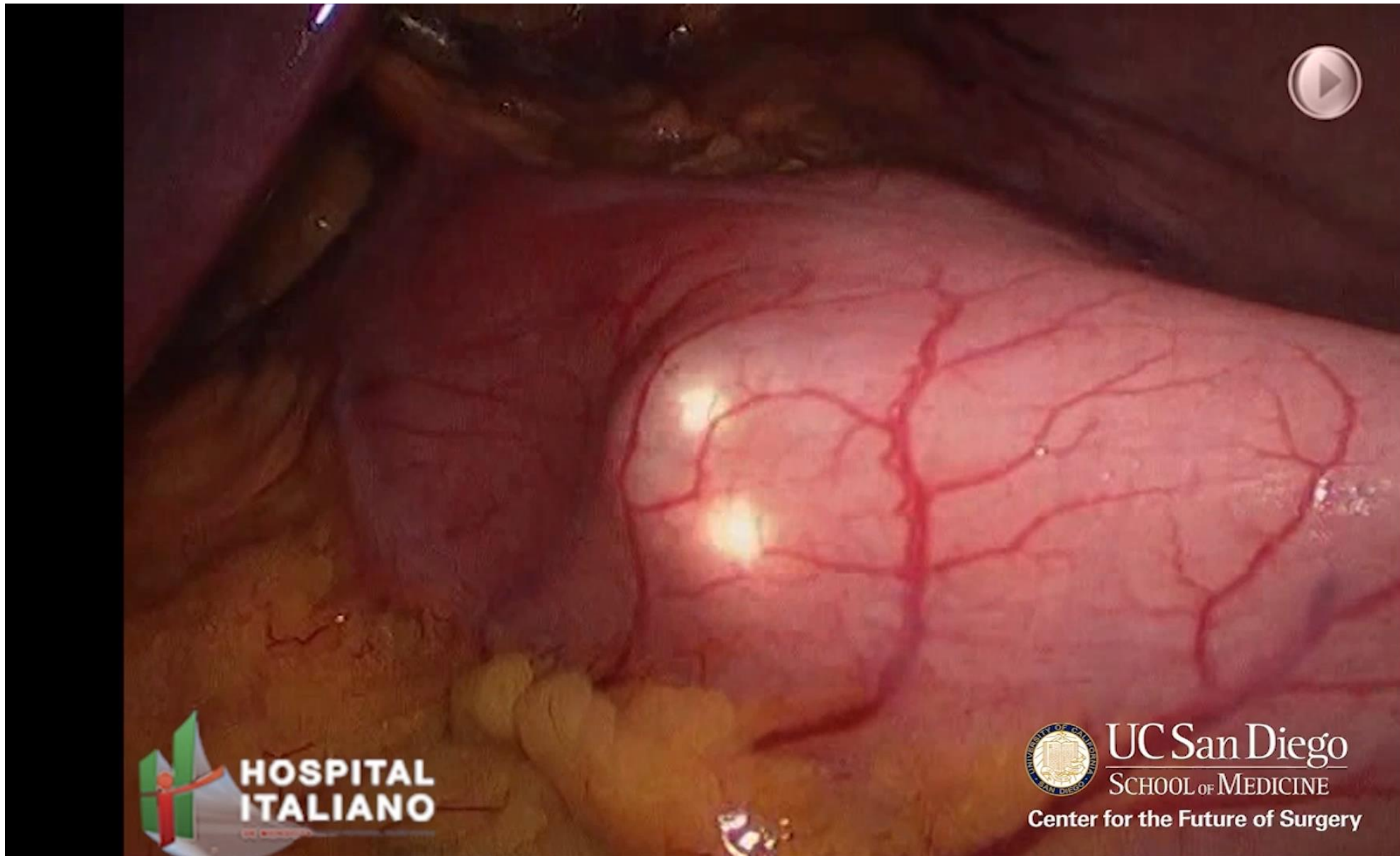
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- Perforated marginal ulcer after OAGB
- Different treatments:
 - Peritoneal lavage + omental patch.
 - Peritoneal lavage + omental patch + Braun omega J-J.
 - Peritoneal lavage + conversion to RYGBP. (resection of previous G-J)
 - Conservative treatment. AB + TPN + Drains.
 - OAGB reversal to normal anatomy.





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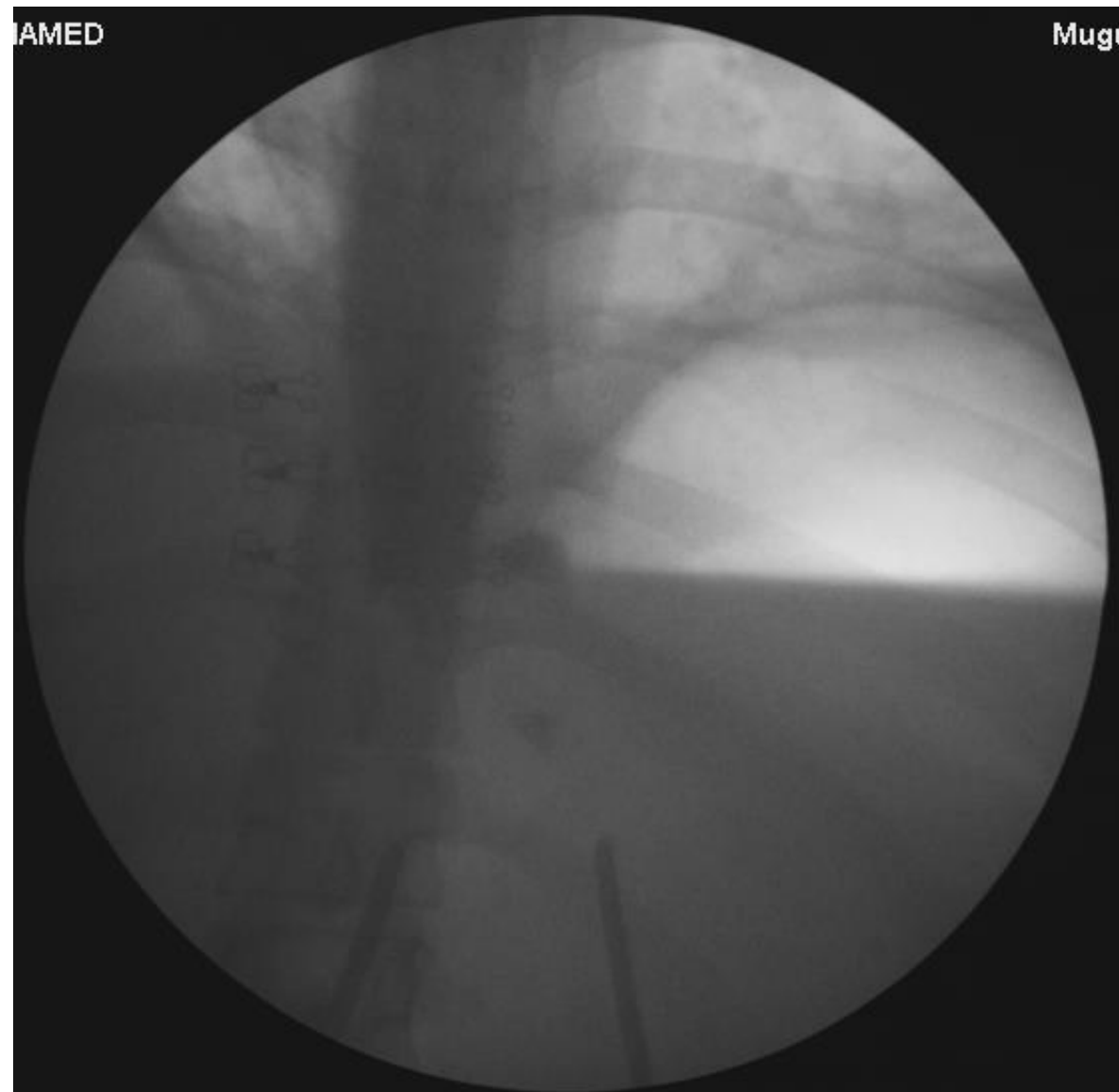


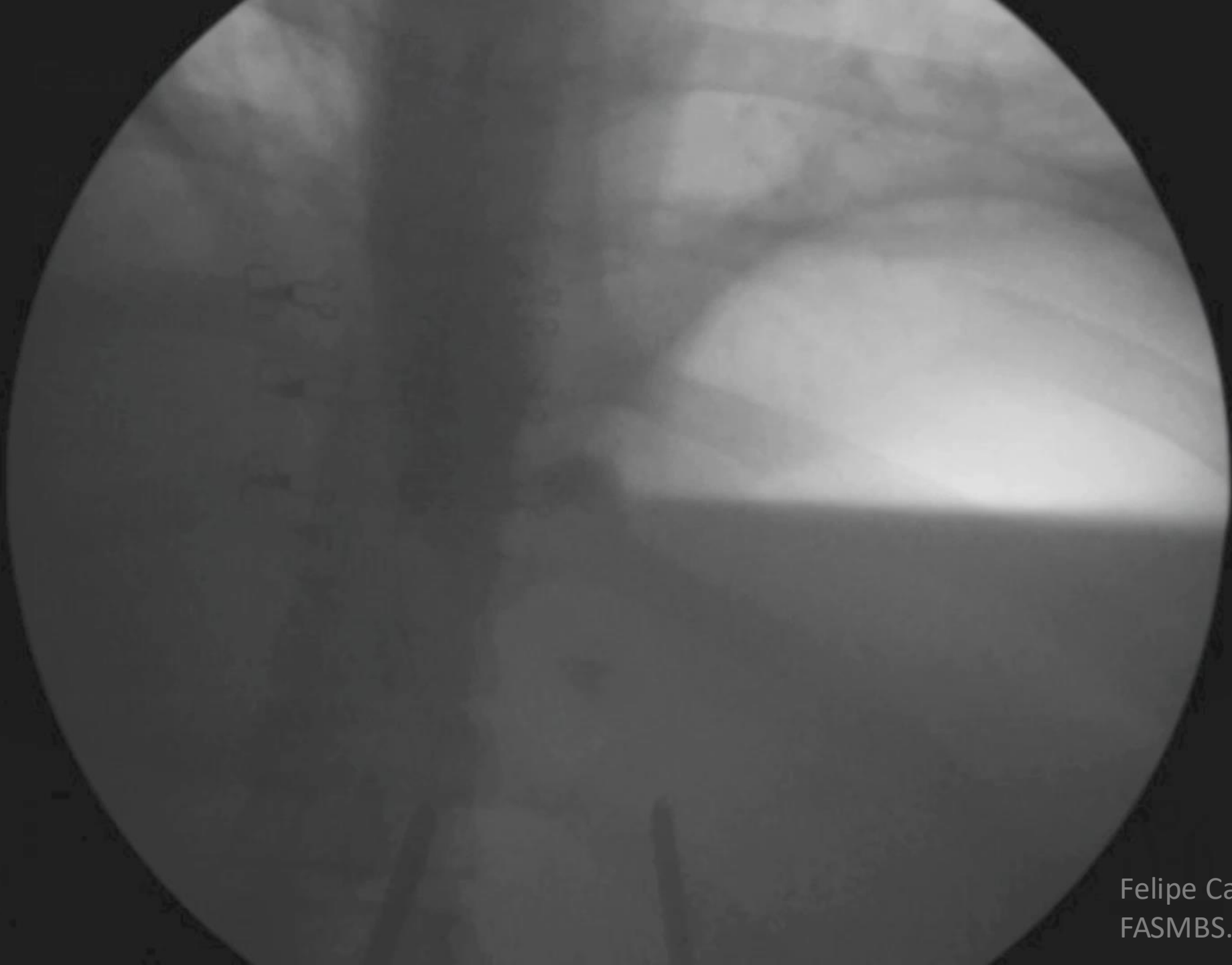
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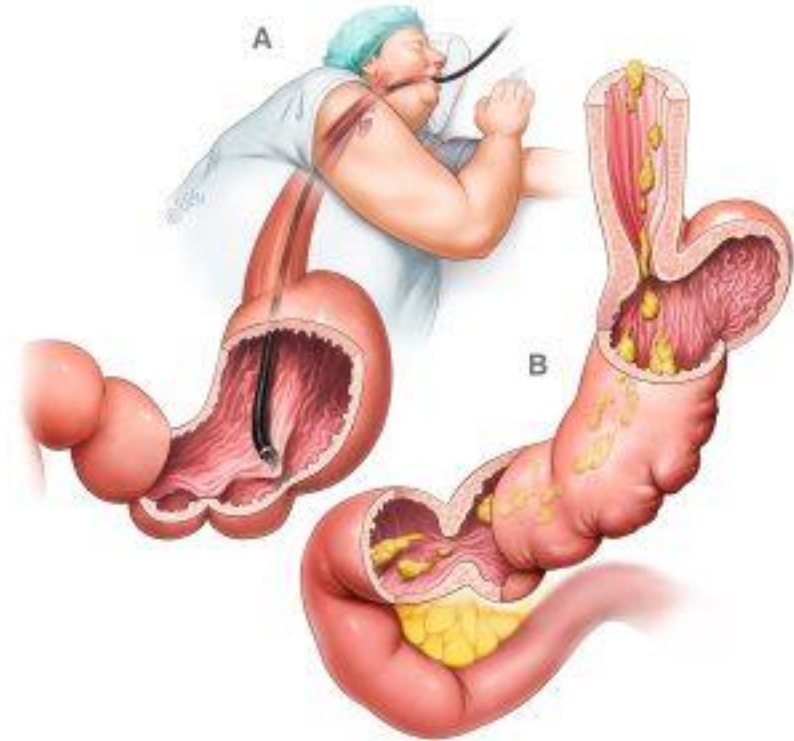


- 36 y/o f

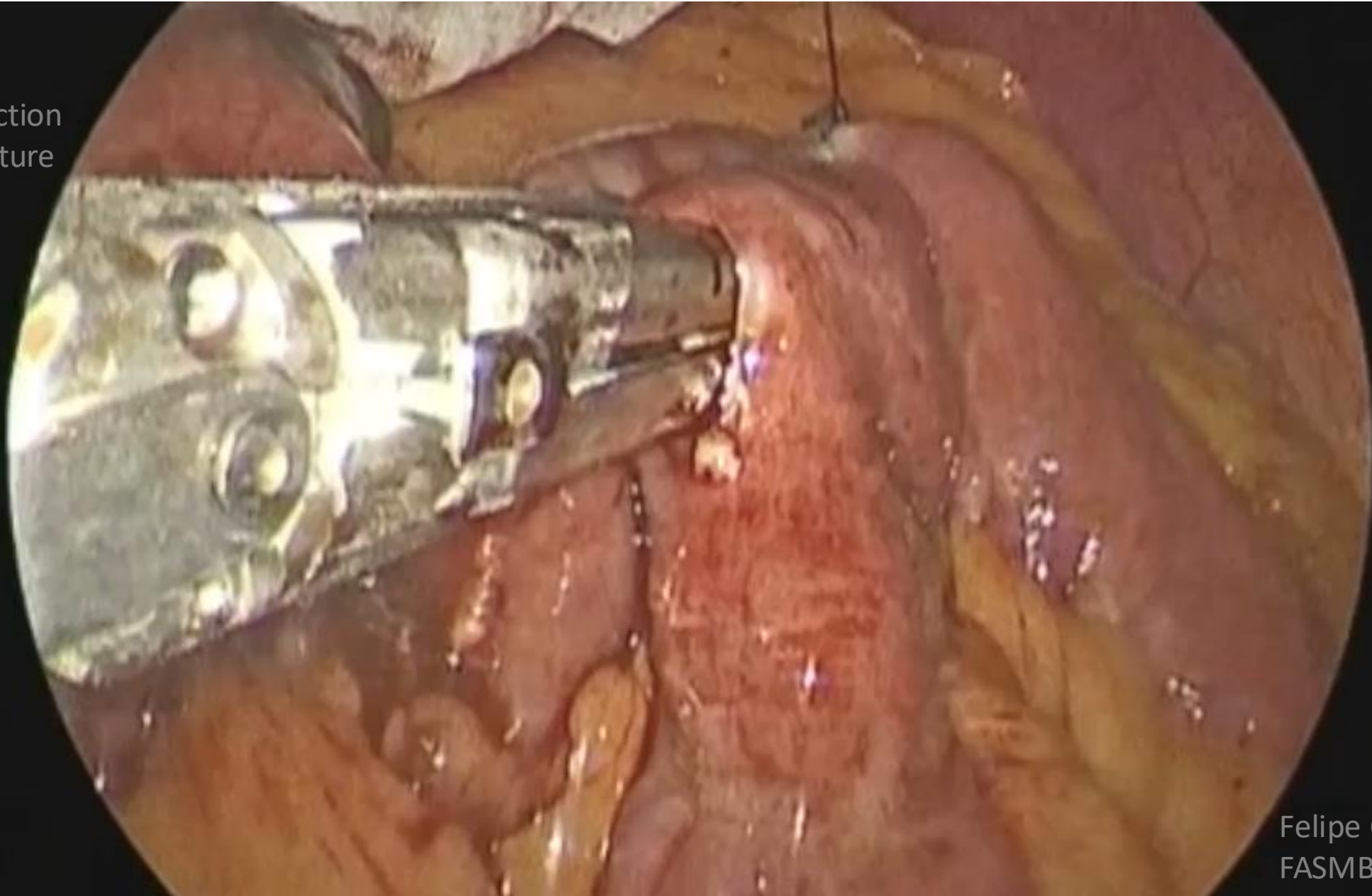

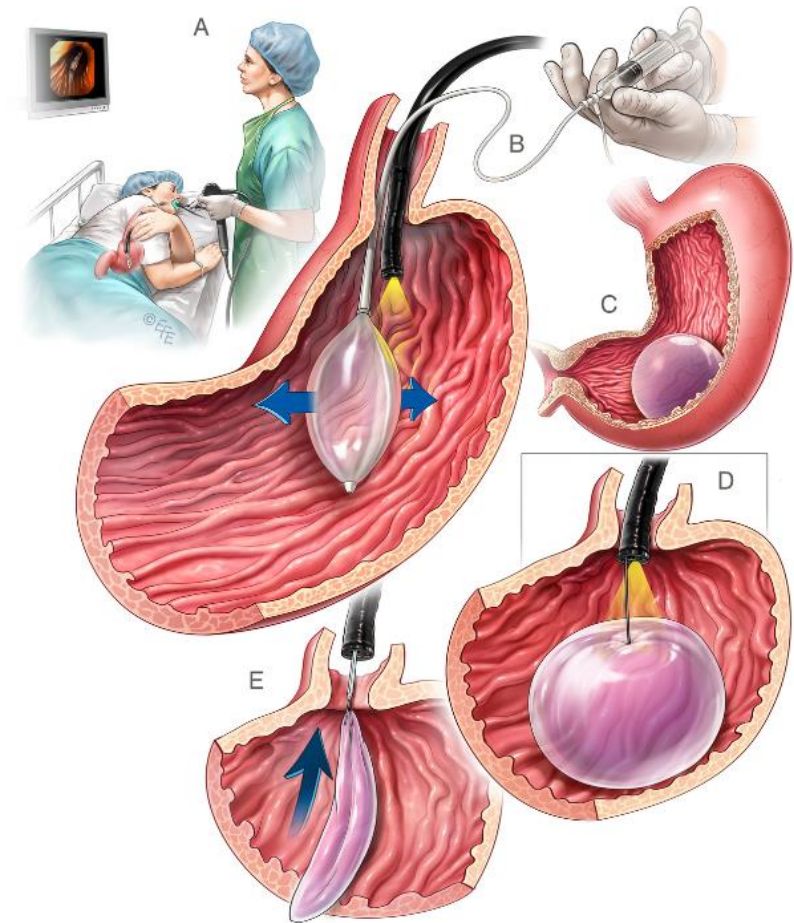
- Lap RNY
