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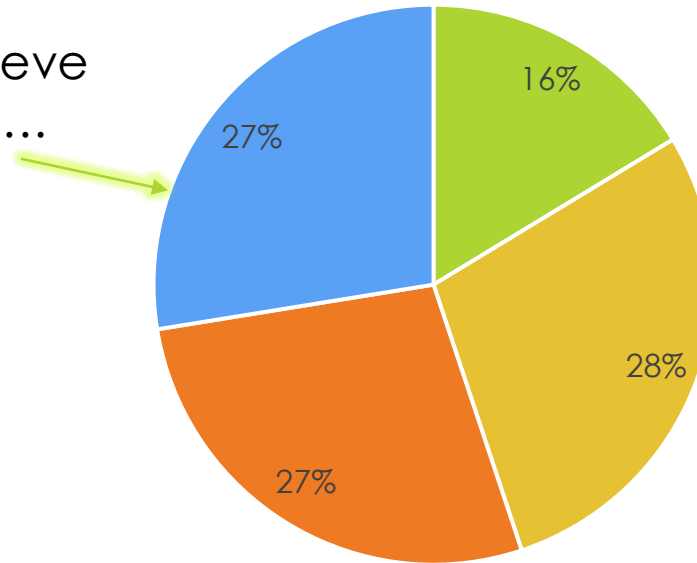

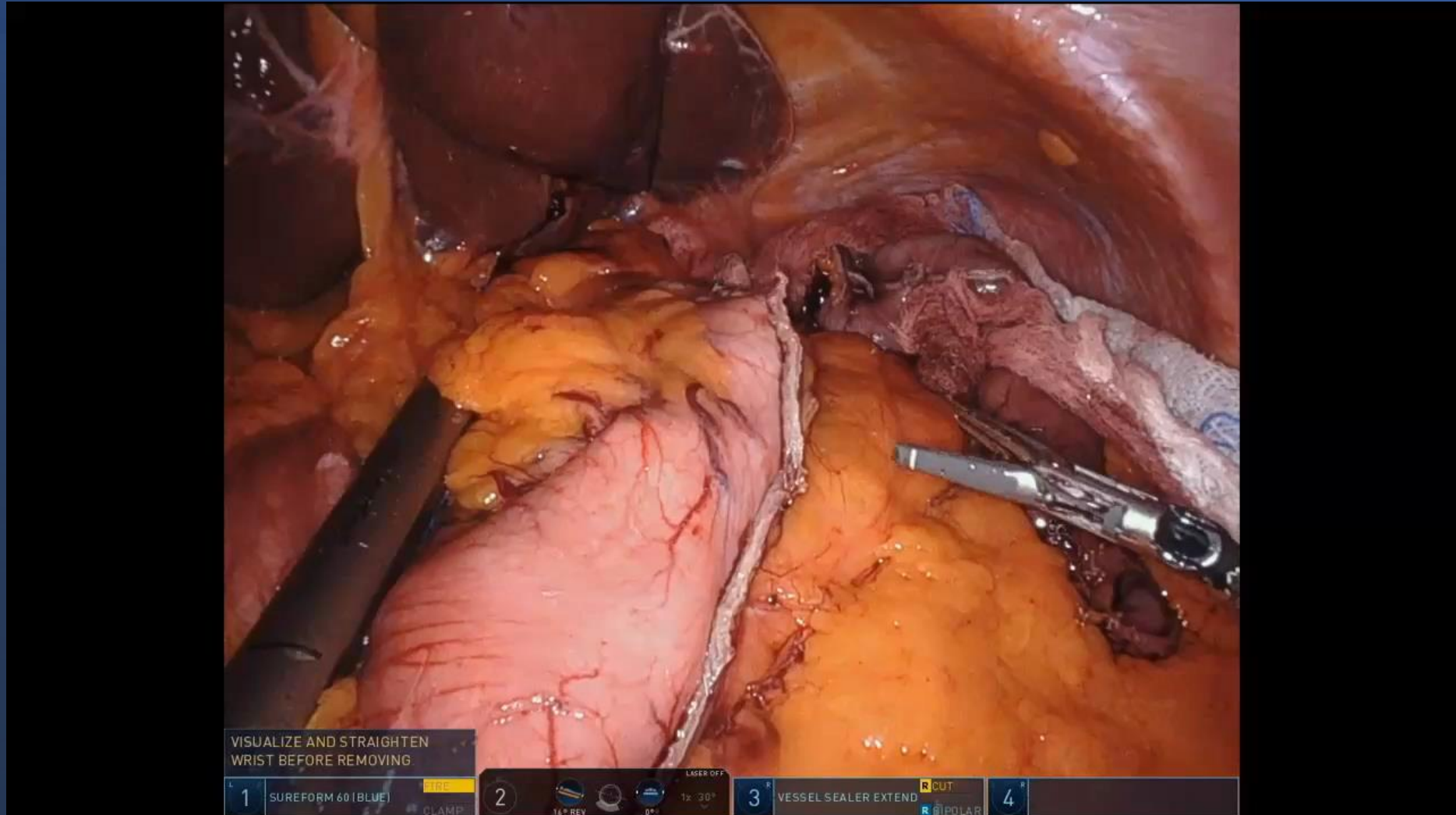

- ▶ Intraluminal injection for staple line leak
 - ▶ 150 consecutive patients- 2.66% increased detection of leak- 4 cases





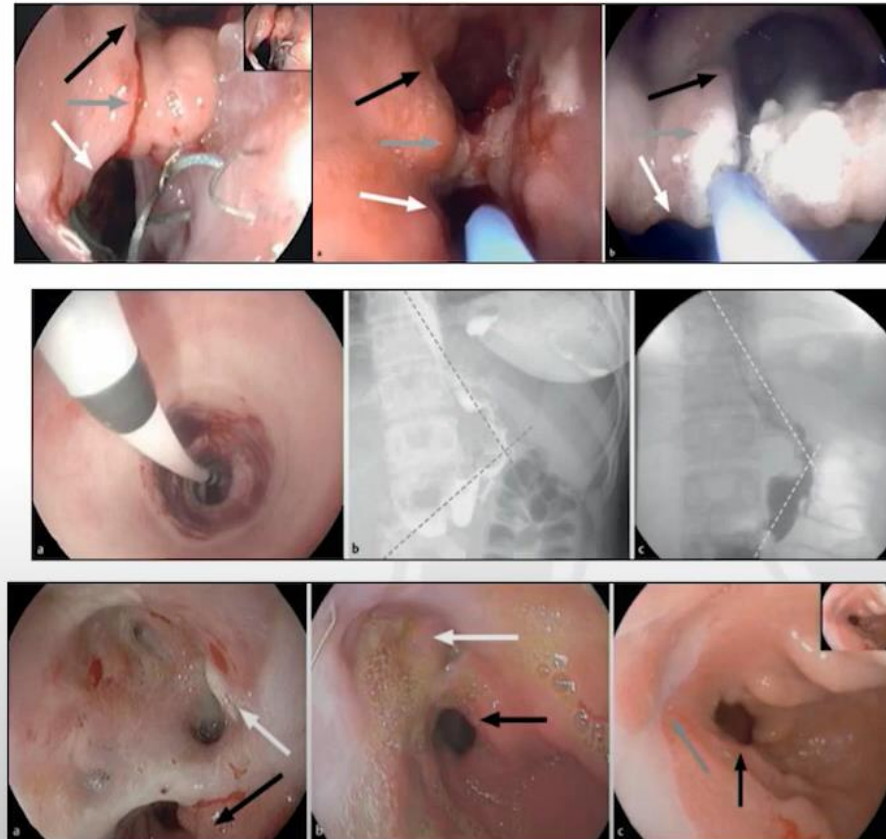

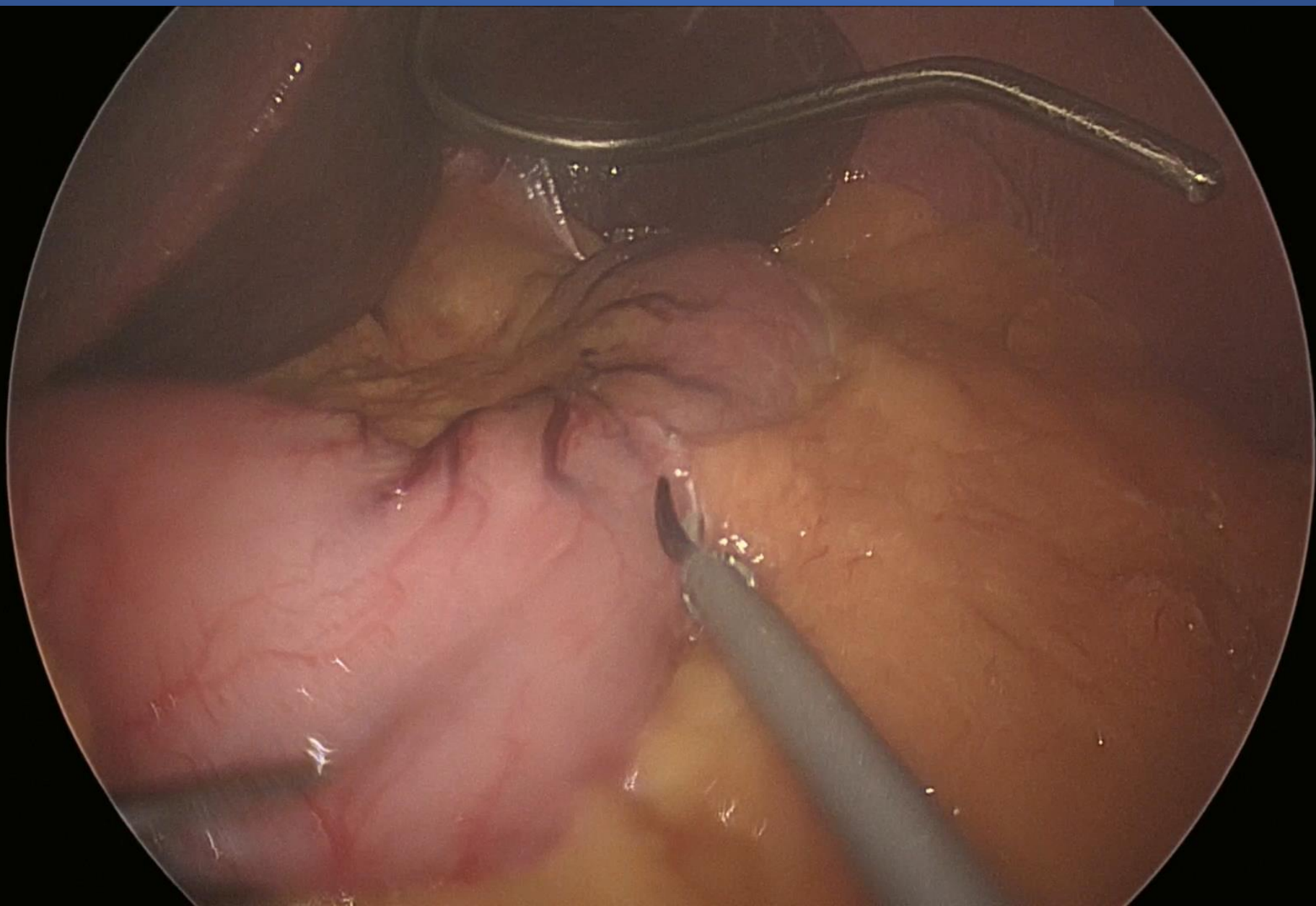

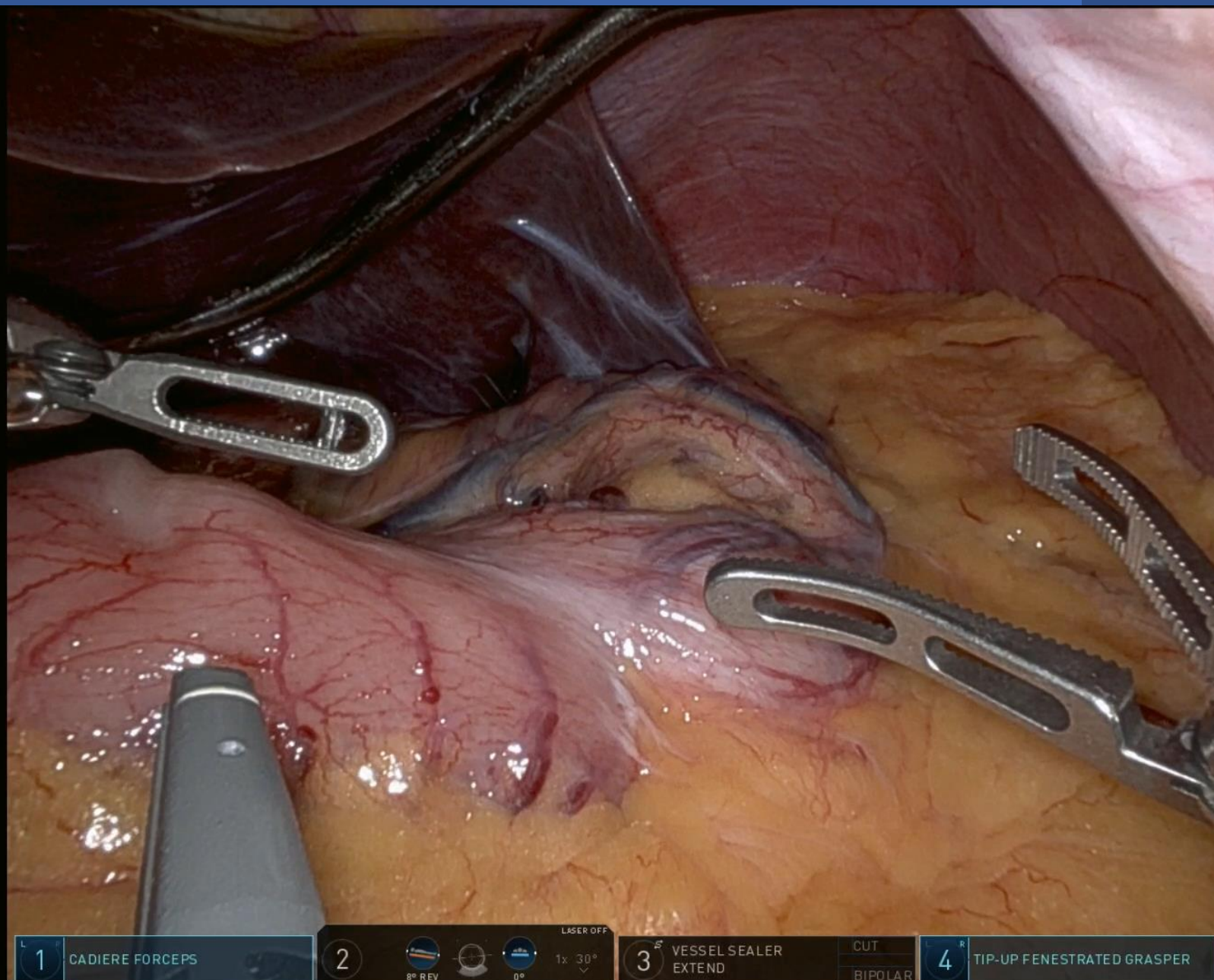
Evidence

Steps in performing a septotomy

- Steps
 - Perform in the OR under general anesthesia
 - EGD to examine anatomy of the leak and sleeve (CO2 insufflation)
 - Clear out abscess cavity of debris to better see the base
 - Use argon or triangular knife
 - Resolve stenosis with balloon dilation
 - Repeat if needed
 - Follow-up egd to ensure resolution

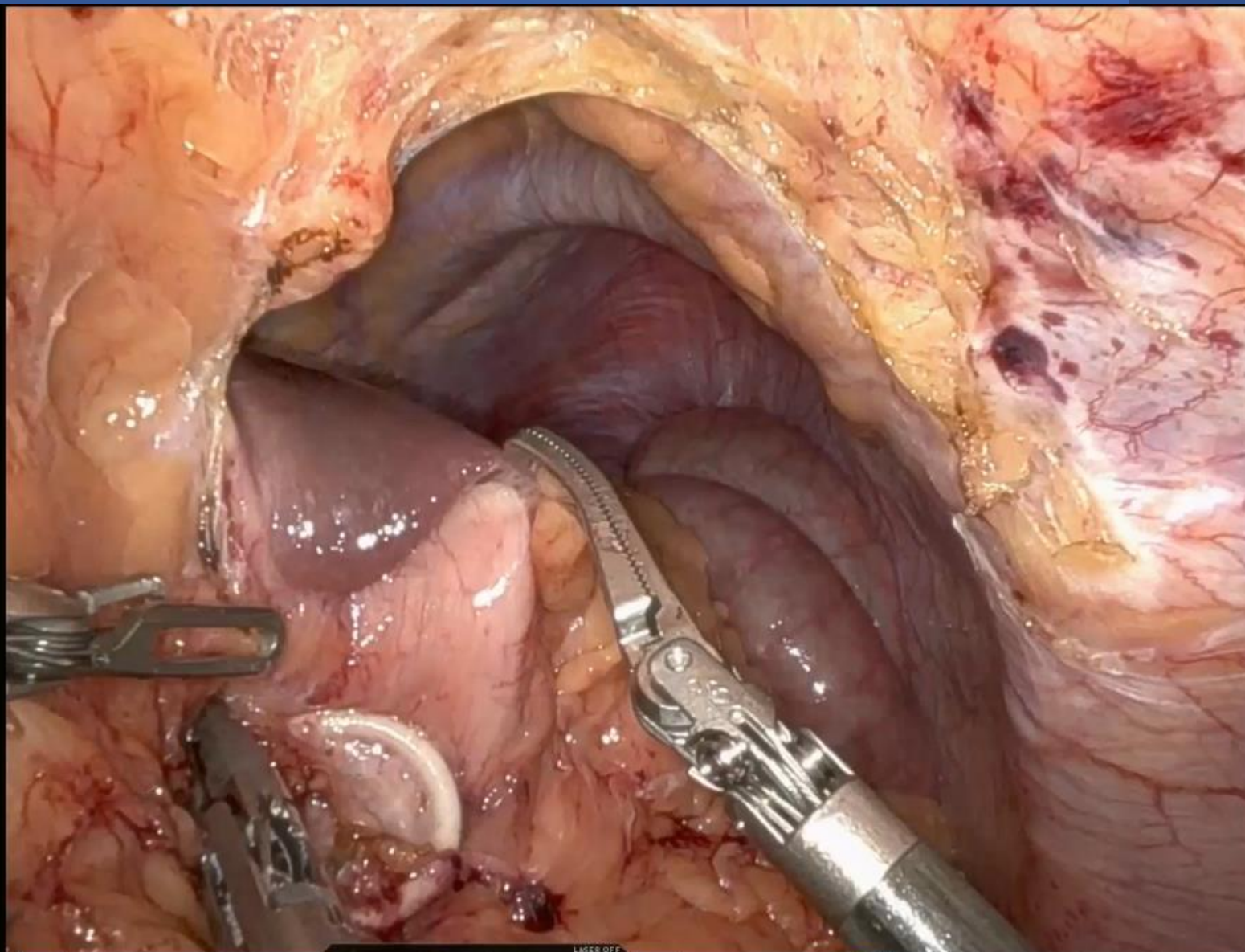

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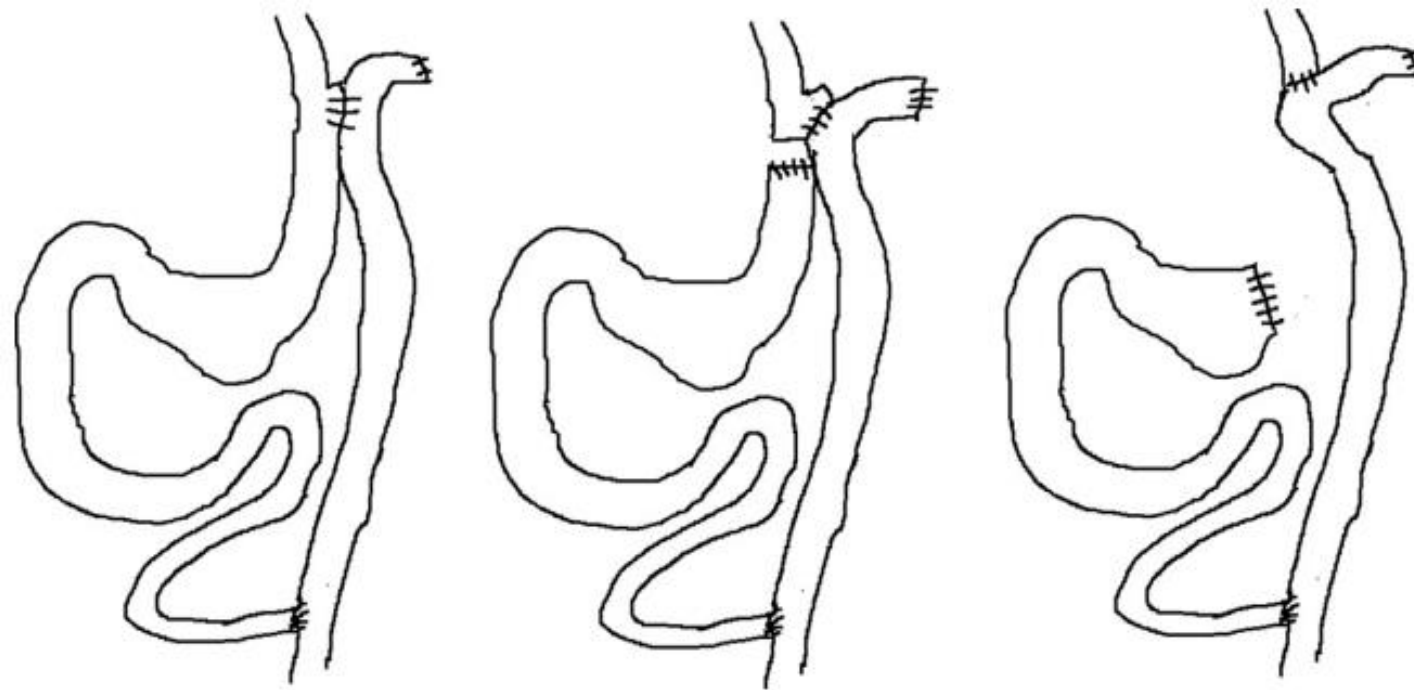


Fig. 2. Types of surgical procedures: (1) gastrojejunal anastomosis, (2) Roux-en-Y gastric bypass, (3) gastrectomy with esoj jejunal anastomosis.
