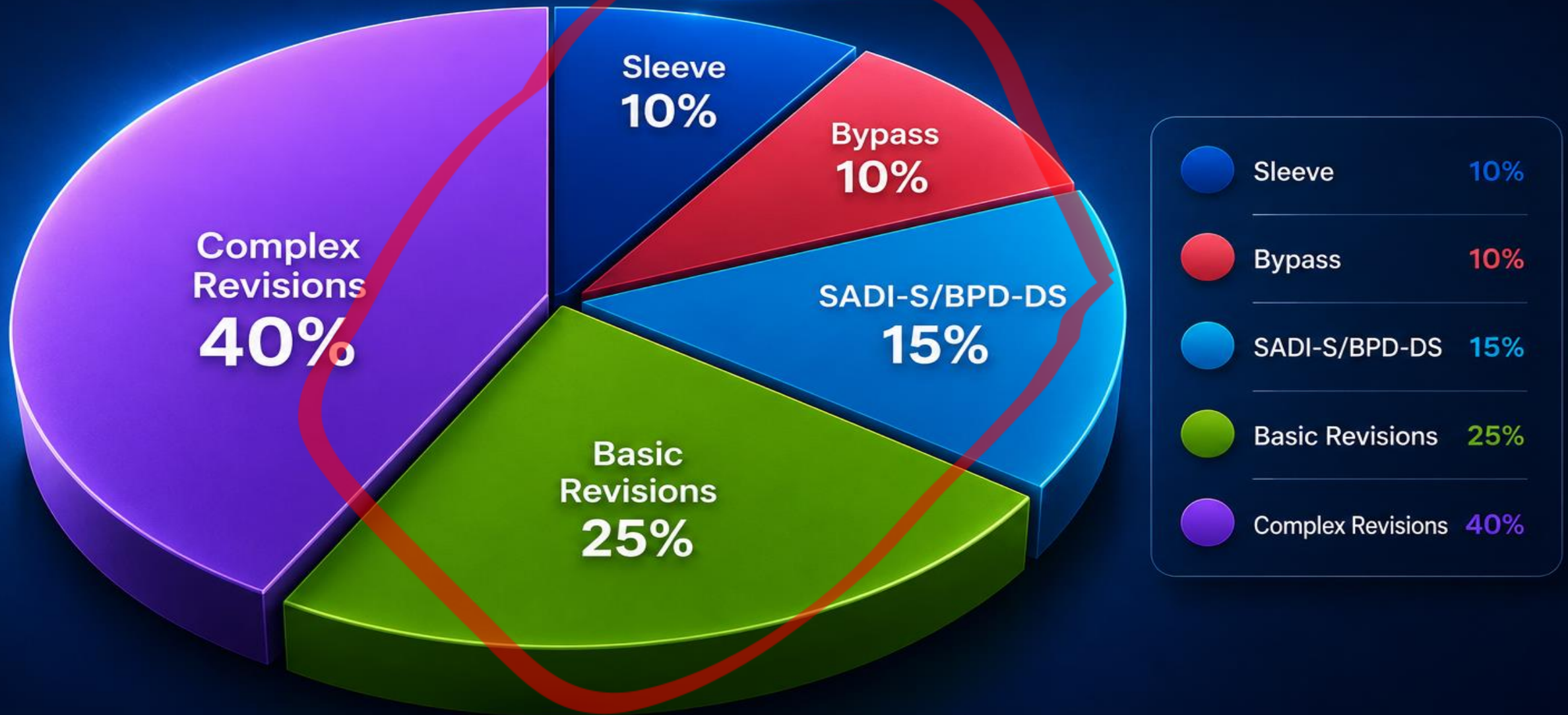

WHY JUST A SURGICAL CASE?



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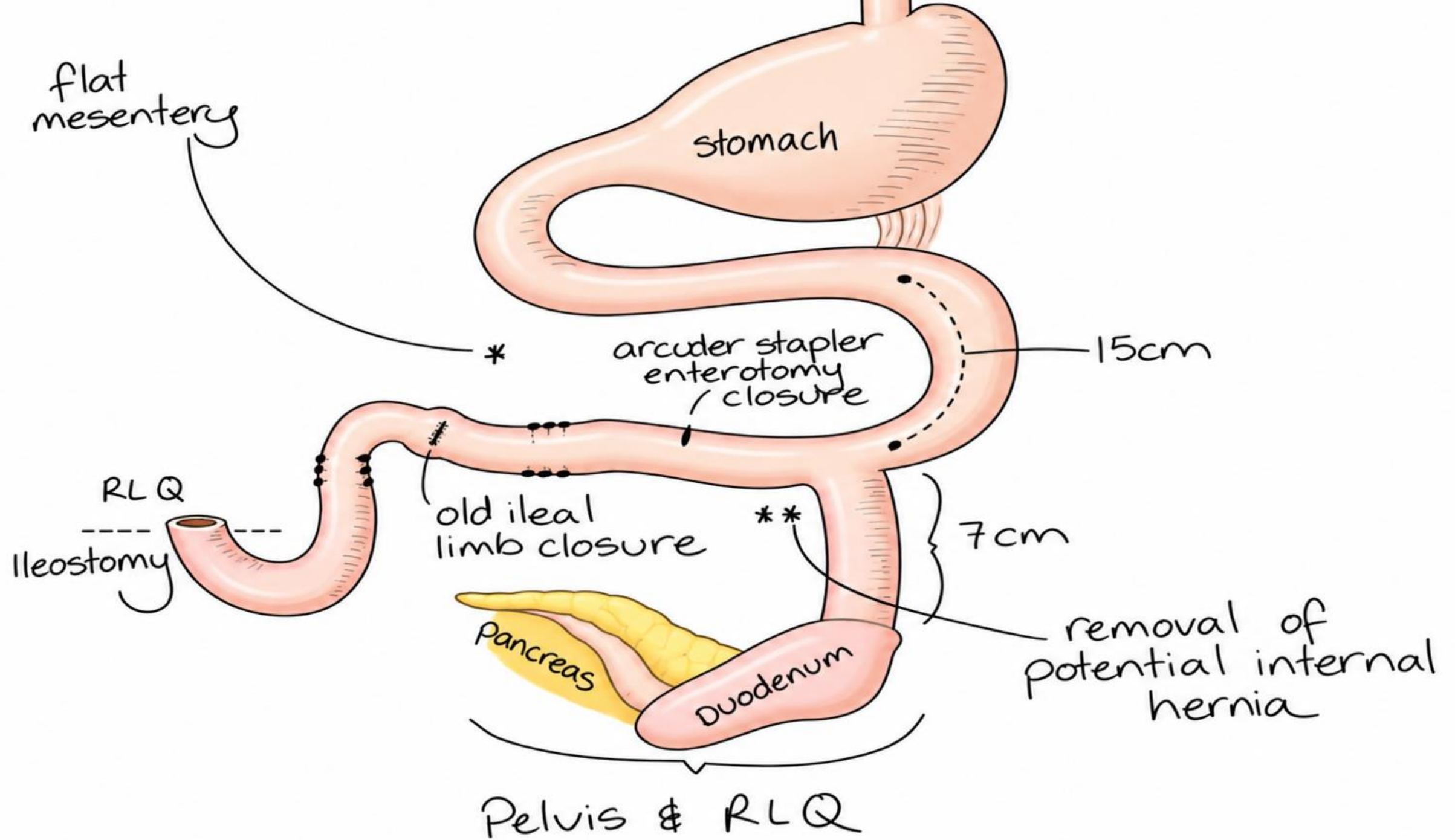


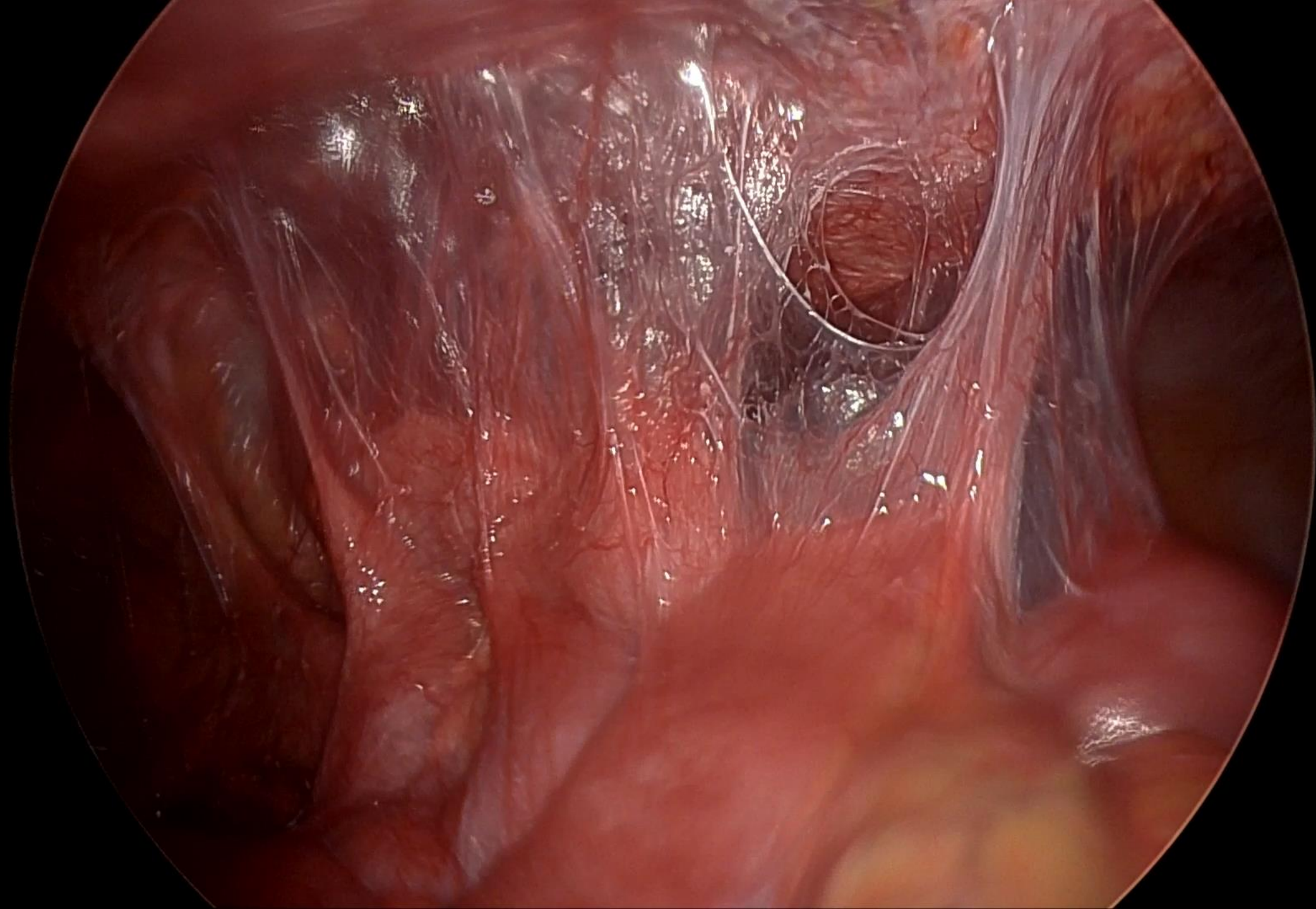
- Better surgical outcomes

- DM1, Kidney Failure
- Kidney and Pancreas TXP
- Redo Pancreas TXP
- Total colectomy
- Redo Pancreas TXP due to internal hernia (revised)
- Failure to thrive
- **SMA Syndrome (UGI, CT scan, NJ feeds)**
